



- **1. Riser** The board attached to the vertical cut surface of a stair stringer.
- **2. Stair Stringer** The diagonal board used to support treads and risers on a stairs.
- **3. Tread** The horizontal surface of a stair.
- **4.** Fascia Horizontal boards used to cover joists.
- **5. Rail Post** The vertical post connected to the deck framing that supports the railing
- **6. Bottom Rail** The lower horizontal piece that connects posts and support balusters
- **7. Baluster** The vertical pieces of a railing spaced ate regular intervals between posts
- **8. Decking** -The boards used to make the walking surface of the deck
- 9. Top Rail The top horizontal trim on a railing
- **10. Post** A vertical framing piece, used to support a beam or a joist
- **11. Post Footing** Concrete filled hole that the post is attached to
- **12. Support Beam** A horizontal framing piece, which rests on posts and support joists
- **13. Joist** A horizontal frame piece that supports the decking and spreads the weight over the beams
